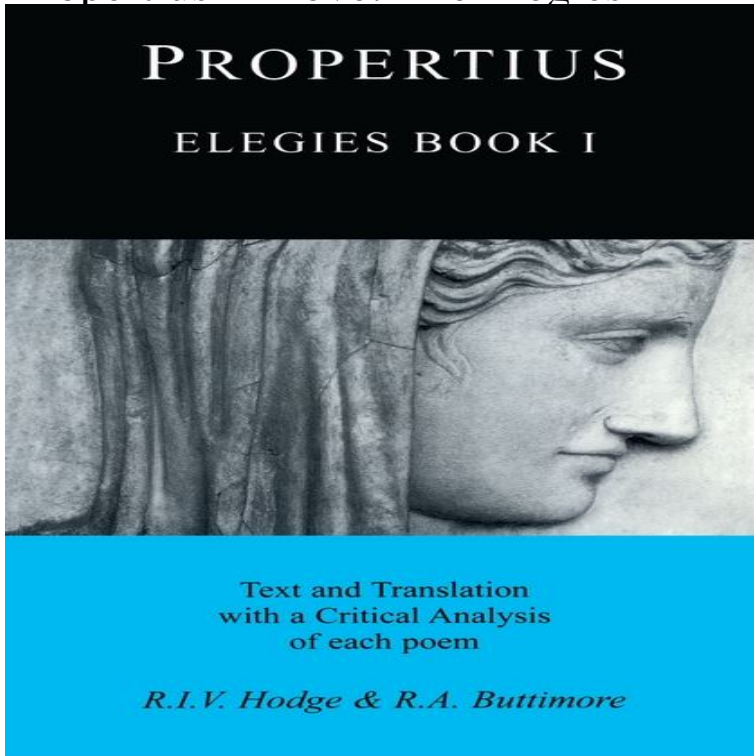


Propertius in Love: The Elegies
