Simple Present Tense Verbs for He/She/It and Singular Nouns

Spelling Rules	Examples
With most verbs, add s	live - lives sit - sits stay - stays
Ending in consonant + y change y to i and add s	try - tries carry - carries
Ending in s, z, ch, or x add es	miss - misses buzz - buzzes catch - catches fix - fixes
Exceptions	go - goes do - does

There are four present tense forms: Present simple: I work. Present continuous: I am working. Present perfect: I have worked. Present perfect continuous: I have been working. We use the simple present tense when an action is happening right now, or when it happens regularly (or unceasingly, which is why it's sometimes called present indefinite). Depending on the person, the simple present tense is formed by using the root form or by adding 's or 'es to the end. The simple present tense is one of several forms of present tense in English. It is used to describe habits, unchanging situations, general truths, and fixed events. Simple Present Tense. The PRESENT TENSE uses the verb's base form (write, work), or, for third-person singular subjects, the base form plus an -s ending (he writes, she works). The present tense usually describes a current event or state of being, but, oddly, the present tense can also describe past and future events. The four present tenses in English. The present indicative of most verbs in modern English has the same form as the infinitive, except for the third-person singular form, which takes the ending -[e]s. The verb be has the forms am, is, are.
