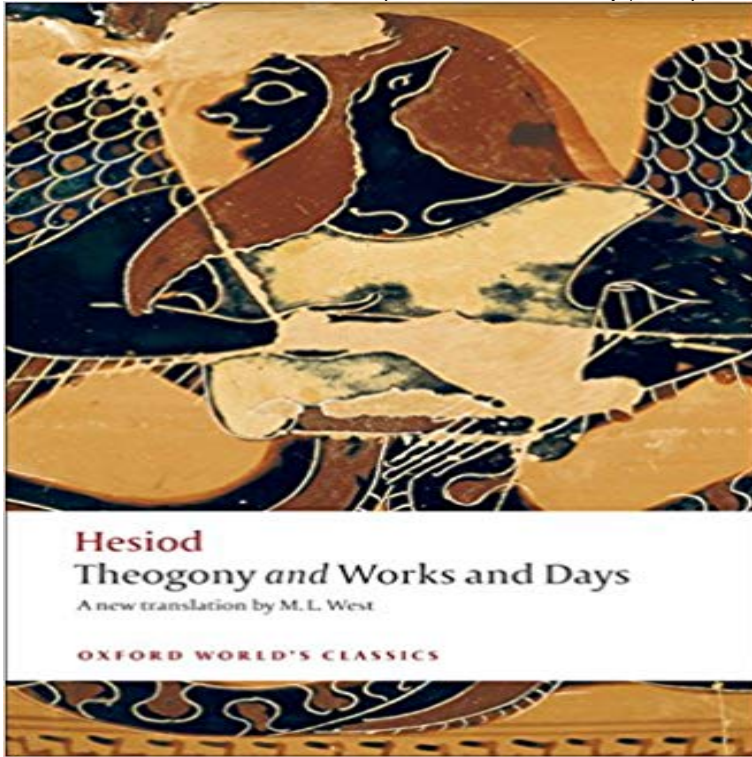


# The Works and Days and Theogony
