The ABCD Disruptions

One of the important discoveries of Win-Win Discipline is that almost all disruptive behavior can be classified into one of four types: ABCD. Almost all disruptive behavior is either Aggression, Breaking the Rules, Confrontation, or Disengagement.



Why is it important to understand the ABCD's of disruptive behavior? We need to respond to each type of disruptive behavior very differently. If a student or class is aggressive, the student or class probably needs to learn cool down procedures, conflict resolution strategies and/or how to disagree politely. If they are often breaking the rules, we need to re-teach the rules or go back to basics and help students see how rules help us reach our goals as a class. If confrontation is the issue, acknowledging student power or a same-side chat may be in order. If students are frequently disengaged, we need to re-examine our curriculum and instruction: Is our curriculum developmentally appropriate? Are we using proven, engaging instructional strategies?

Understanding the ABCD's of Disruptions are signposts directing us to effective responses in the moment-of-disruption as well as appropriate preventative procedures.

The Seven Positions

How do we get to Win-Win outcomes? Outcomes that meet the needs of disruptive students while meeting the teacher's need to teach and for all students to learn? At essence it is simple: Win-Win Discipline is based on the concept of "Positions." Almost every disruption springs from an attempt to meet needs associated with one of seven positions. Positions are "the place a student is at." For example, the student who is constantly asking questions, clowning around, has something to add to everyone else's comment, makes strange noises, blurts out, and dresses loudly, is almost certainly in a position of seeking attention.
